## SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

To encourage tomorrow's leaders to further their knowledge of Municipal Government, the Mississippi Municipal League annually presents three \$2000 scholarships.

**The scholarship competition is open to any high school senior in Mississippi who plans to attend an accredited community college, college or university in Mississippi.**

### **The MML General Scholarship**

is open to all high school seniors and is co-sponsored by Mississippi Power Company.

### **The MML Limited Scholarship**

is open to children or grandchildren of employees or elected officials of Mississippi municipalities and to high school seniors working part-time for a member municipality of the Mississippi Municipal League and is co-sponsored by Phelps Dunbar.

### **The Mississippi Municipal Service Company Limited Scholarship**

is open to children or grandchildren of employees or elected officials of Mississippi municipalities that are members of the Mississippi Municipal Liability Plan or the Mississippi Municipal Workers' Compensation Group.

The winners and their parents will be recognized in July at the MML Awards Luncheon during the Mississippi Municipal League Annual Conference on the Gulf Coast. Winners are expected to attend the awards ceremony. In addition, the winning essays will be published in the Mississippi Municipalities magazine.

### **Rules**

A student may only apply for one scholarship. To apply, a student must complete the application form and write an essay using the prompt: **"From the Classroom to City Hall: How Youth Voices Can Shape Local Government."** The essay must be 2,000 words or less and typed doubled-spaced on plain paper. The student's name may appear only on the application.

### **Important**

On a separate sheet of paper, please list your grade point average and community activities. Reference to race, gender, name of high school or where you live is not permitted on activities sheet or essay. Essays will be judged by a panel selected by the Mississippi Municipal League. The \$2000 scholarship awards will be issued directly to the institutions of higher learning and deposited in the winning students' accounts.
